HOW TO MAKE A GOOD THANKSGIVING AFTER COMMUNION

Here is how we can make our thanksgiving:

1. Keep silent and adore
2. Listen to Jesus
3. Speak to Jesus
4. Ask of Jesus
5. Give to Jesus
6. Radiate the Host

Let there be silence in your soul!...We ought to close “doors” and “windows,” i.e., lower our eyes, become deaf to the world’s din, mortify our imaginations, and let no worldly thoughts or too captivating images of any creature enter in. Jesus dwells in our “little church”; he ought to dwell there alone- let us make a sanctuary of love and recollection for him.

As you see, we are not talking about daydreaming, or idleness, or distractions, but silence. Or, in other words, of a delightful and mute contemplation, of a heart to heart converse with our King, with our Beloved. It is all to our advantage, then, to forget ourselves and to think only of Jesus. He will take care of us. He is active within us. We have merely to *let* him act; to let him divinise us; and look at him lovingly, with one of those inexpressible in human

speech, into which all that is best in our soul passes. Two hearts, as it were, beat in our breast -the Saviour’s heart and our own. And these two hearts-if we do not put some obstacle in the way, will beat in unison-one *for* the other and One *in* the other. He will love us, and we shall love Him; He will look at us, and we at Him. In Him we shall find life: a life of intimate union.

Jesus speaks in the silence. He always has something to say to us, some confidence to impart to us. If we do not hear him, it may be because we do not know how to be silent, being too eager to say certain prayers; or, again, being too interested *not* to hear, lest our Divine Friend ask of us some thing we do not wish to promise, or some sacrifice we do not wish to make! Sometimes, too, we avoid his eyes; sometimes, too, we close our ears to his divine appeal...Such shall be our conduct no longer. Let us rather say, “Speak, Lord, for your servant hears.”

We, in turn, converse with our Lord. We speak to him simply and sincerely, as to a friend.

We start by thanking Him for coming to us. We talk to Him of our love for Him...our wishes...our worries...our sins...our temptations...our plans...our joys...our troubles...our apostolate...all the Church’s needs, etc.

During our thanksgiving, then, we shall beg Jesus for spiritual and temporal graces or favours for ourselves and others.
